As an emergent learning center, Play & Say's Pre-K Prep Program is socially relevant, intellectually engaging, and personally meaningful to children and their families. In emergent learning, both children and adults take initiative and make decisions regarding the curriculum.

#### **Reggio Emelia Inspiration**

We have chosen to model our program and methodology on the concepts promoted through the Reggio Emilia schools in Italy. The Reggio Emilia framework is an approach to early childhood education that emphasizes the child's role in his/her learning and development of self. Activities are handcrafted based on the unique interests of the learners in our class.

#### **Montessori Influence**

The child's environment and experiences fosters discovery of their true potential and development of an organized, engaged, and focused mind. The Montessori experience prepares children to be curious, lifelong learners, as well as good citizens, future innovators, and able leaders.

#### The Image of The Child

Teaching is not adult directed—it is rooted in the concept and the belief that children are constructors of their own learning.

#### The Role of The Teacher

We see children as participants in the learning process—not just passive vessels – allows the teachers and adults in the program to share in the process while guiding and mentoring children's ideas.



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#### **Community of Learners**

As a community of learners we have the responsibility to develop our understanding and knowledge of the child's experience within his/her family and community and to extend an open invitation to the child's family to be an active member of our Community of Learners.

#### Environment as a Third Teacher

The classroom environment was inspired by Maria Montessori including areas for specific skill building, child-sized chairs and tables, and materials that promote self-help and independence.

The curriculum is a child-centered, play-oriented, emergent curriculum developed specifically to prepare children for the demands of kindergarten.
